AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in terms and courses of study, providing for Asian-American and Pacific Islander history 5 6 instruction. 7 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known 10 11 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a 12 section to read: 1.3 Section 1555. Asian-American and Pacific Islander History 14 Instruction. -- (a) The Department of Education shall develop a 15 model curriculum for students in kindergarten through grade 16 twelve on Asian-American and Pacific Islander history. 17 (b) The instruction under subsection (a) shall: 18 (1) Be age appropriate.
- 19 (2) Be seguential in method of study.

- 1 (3) Communicate the connection between national, ethnic or
- 2 <u>racial intolerance</u>.
- 3 (4) Communicate the impact of personal responsibility, civic
- 4 engagement and societal response within the context of paragraph
- 5 (3).
- 6 (c) A school entity may utilize appropriate public or
- 7 private resources to develop and implement this section. The
- 8 <u>Department of Education shall distribute information about</u>
- 9 appropriate curriculum materials to each school entity.
- 10 (d) Beginning with the 2024-2025 school year, each school
- 11 entity may offer instruction on Asian-American and Pacific
- 12 <u>Islander history and the social, political and economic</u>
- 13 <u>contributions of members of the Asian-American and Pacific</u>
- 14 Islander community. This instruction may be integrated within
- 15 the social studies and language arts courses of study required
- 16 in accordance with State Board of Education regulations.
- 17 Instruction may also be integrated into other appropriate
- 18 courses of study.
- 19 (e) The Department of Education may contract with and work
- 20 in consultation with other organizations to develop curriculum
- 21 under this section, including the Governor's Advisory Commission
- 22 <u>on Asian Pacific American Affairs.</u>
- 23 (f) The curriculum under this section may include the
- 24 history of Asian Americans and Pacific Islanders in Pennsylvania
- 25 and the history of Asian Americans and Pacific Islanders in the
- 26 United States as a whole, including the contributions of Asian
- 27 Americans and Pacific Islanders toward advancing civil rights
- 28 from the 19th century onward. The curriculum may also include
- 29 contributions made by individual Asian Americans and Pacific
- 30 Islanders in government and the arts, humanities and sciences,

- 1 <u>as well as the contributions of Asian-American and Pacific</u>
- 2 <u>Islander communities to the economic, cultural, social and</u>
- 3 political development of the United States.
- 4 (g) Beginning with the 2024-2025 school year, the Department
- 5 of Education shall make available to all school entities the
- 6 <u>curriculum described under this section</u>, including any and all
- 7 appropriate curriculum information and materials. The Department
- 8 of Education shall also provide curriculum guidelines, in-
- 9 <u>service training programs and any other materials developed for</u>
- 10 the curriculum to any nonpublic school upon request.
- (h) Beginning with the 2024-2025 school year, each school
- 12 entity shall provide programs on Asian-American and Pacific
- 13 <u>Islander history for instructors, utilizing the Department of</u>
- 14 Education's curriculum as part of the Department of Education's
- 15 <u>in-service training programs. School employes shall receive</u>
- 16 continuing professional education credits for engaging in in-
- 17 service training programs developed under this section.
- 18 (i) The State Board of Education shall:
- 19 (1) Conduct a study on instruction offered in Asian-American
- 20 <u>and Pacific Islander history.</u>
- 21 (2) Request that each school entity provide the State Board
- 22 of Education with information concerning whether the school
- 23 entity offers instruction in Asian-American and Pacific Islander
- 24 history and the manner in which that instruction is offered.
- 25 (3) Issue a report on the instruction of Asian-American and
- 26 Pacific Islander history in the 2025-2026 school year no later
- 27 than November 30, 2026, to the Governor, the Secretary of
- 28 Education, the chairperson and minority chairperson of the
- 29 Education Committee of the Senate and the chairperson and
- 30 minority chairperson of the Education Committee of the House of

- 1 Representatives.
- 2 (j) The State Board of Education report under subsection (i)
- 3 shall include the following:
- 4 (1) The number of school entities offering instruction in
- 5 Asian-American and Pacific Islander history.
- 6 (2) The number of school entities using the curriculum and
- 7 <u>quidelines established by the Department of Education.</u>
- 8 (3) The number of school entities using the in-service
- 9 training programs made available by the Department of Education
- 10 under this section.
- 11 (4) A description of how school entities are offering
- 12 instruction in Asian-American and Pacific Islander history,
- 13 which shall include:
- 14 <u>(i) The number of hours of instruction offered.</u>
- 15 (ii) The grade levels at which instruction is offered.
- 16 (iii) The course or courses in which the instruction is
- 17 integrated.
- 18 (iv) Recommendations for improvements to the offering of
- 19 instruction in Asian-American and Pacific Islander history,
- 20 including recommended legislation.
- 21 (k) The Department of Education shall promulgate regulations
- 22 necessary for the implementation of this section. If the report
- 23 and study conducted by the State Board of Education under
- 24 subsection (i) demonstrates that less than ninety percent of
- 25 school entities offer instruction in Asian-American and Pacific
- 26 Islander history consistent with the instruction and curriculum
- 27 provided by the Department of Education, the Department of
- 28 Education shall adopt regulations to require all school entities
- 29 to offer instruction in Asian-American and Pacific Islander
- 30 history.

- 1 (1) For purposes of this section, the term "school entity"
- 2 <u>shall mean a school district, charter school, regional charter</u>
- 3 <u>school</u>, <u>cyber charter school</u>, <u>intermediate unit or area career</u>
- 4 and technical school.
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
