1 2 3	Amending Title 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in Commonwealth services, further providing for Fire Safety Advisory Committee.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 7386(a) of Title 35 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
8	§ 7386. Fire Safety Advisory Committee.
9	(a) Creation
10	(1) There is created the Fire Safety Advisory Committee
11	to assist the commissioner. The committee shall consist of
12	[nine] the following members[, as follows]:
13	(i) The director of the agency, ex officio.
14	(ii) The commissioner, who shall serve as chairman.
15	(iii) Four paid firefighters as follows:
16	(A) Two paid firefighters to be appointed by the
17	Governor, one from a city of the first class and one
18	from a city of the second class.

1	(B) Two paid firefighters to be appointed by the
2	Governor from a list of at least six nominees
3	submitted by the Pennsylvania Professional
4	Firefighters Association.

- (iv) One member of the public to be appointed by the Governor.
- (v) [Four] <u>Six</u> volunteer firefighters, [one each] <u>two each</u> to be appointed by the President pro tempore of the Senate[, the Minority Leader of the Senate,] <u>and</u> the Speaker of the House of Representatives <u>and one each to be appointed by the Minority Leader of the Senate</u> and the Minority Leader of the House of Representatives.
- (2) Members of the committee shall serve at the pleasure of their appointing authority. The committee shall advise the commissioner on matters pertaining to the operation of the Pennsylvania State Fire Academy and any other matters as the commissioner may request.
