## AN ACT

1 2 3 4	Amending Title 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in local organizations and services, further providing for general authority of political subdivisions.
5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Section 7501(d) of Title 35 of the Pennsylvania
8	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
9	§ 7501. General authority of political subdivisions.

11	(d) Temporary suspension of formal requirementsEach
12	political subdivision included in a declaration of disaster
13	emergency declared by either the Governor or the governing body
14	of the political subdivision affected by the disaster emergency
15	is authorized to exercise the powers vested under this section
16	in the light of the exigencies of the emergency situation
17	without regard to time-consuming procedures and formalities
18	prescribed by law (excepting mandatory constitutional

1 requirements) pertaining to the performance of public work, entering into contracts, the incurring of obligations, the 2 3 employment of temporary workers, the rental of equipment, the purchase of supplies and materials, the levying of taxes and the 4 appropriation and expenditure of public funds. Notwithstanding 5 any other provision of law, the governing body of a political 6 7 subdivision shall not be required to have a quorum physically 8 present at any one location in order to conduct business if a quorum is otherwise established by the participating members 9 through an authorized telecommunication device. Notwithstanding 10 the provisions of this section or law, a meeting or hearing 11 conducted under this section shall provide, to the extent 12 13 practicable, advance notice to the public of each meeting and 14 for participation in the meeting or hearing. 15 \* \* \*

16 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
