14	Section 111. Criminal History of Employes [and], Prospective
15	Employes <u>and Volunteers</u> ; Conviction of Certain Offenses* * *
16	(c.3) (1) If a public or private school, intermediate unit
17	or area vocational-technical school requires a volunteer to
18	submit a report of criminal history record information that
19	satisfies subsection (b) or a set of fingerprints for Federal
20	criminal history record information that satisfies subsection

1	(c.1), then the public or private school, intermediate unit or
2	area vocational-technical school shall reimburse the volunteer
3	for the cost of obtaining the information.
4	(2) The Department of Education shall, to the extent funds
5	are appropriated or otherwise made available to the department
6	for such purpose, pay each public or private school,
7	intermediate unit or area vocational-technical school for the
8	costs incurred in obtaining the information specified in
9	paragraph (1) from volunteers.
10	(3) For purposes of this subsection, a "volunteer" is a
11	person who provides services to a public or private school,
12	intermediate unit or area vocational-technical school without
13	compensation or other remuneration from the public or private
14	school, intermediate unit or area vocational-technical school
15	for the services.
