Amending Title 71 (State Government) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in membership, credited service, classes of service and eligibility for benefits, further 2 3 providing for mandatory and optional membership. 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Section 5301 of Title 71 of the Pennsylvania 8 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read: 9 § 5301. Mandatory and optional membership in the system and 10 participation in the plan. 11 12 (b.2) Time for electing membership. --(1) Notwithstanding any provision of this part to the 13 contrary, an individual who becomes a State employee as an 14 15 officer listed in subsection (a) (1), (2) or (3) on or after 16 the effective date of this subsection and who is not a member 17 of the system may elect membership within 365 days of taking 18 office. 19 (2) A State employee as an officer listed in subsection

- 1 (a) (1), (2) or (3) who, on the effective date of this
- 2 <u>subsection</u>, is not a member of the system may elect_
- 3 membership within 365 days of the effective date of this
- 4 <u>subsection</u>.
- 5 (3) State employees who do not elect membership within
- 6 the time allowed in this subsection shall not thereafter have
- 7 <u>the option to elect membership except after a bona fide</u>
- 8 termination of State service and return to State service in a
- 9 <u>position allowing membership.</u>

- 11 Section 2. Nothing in this act shall be construed as
- 12 abrogating any regulation promulgated by the State Employees'
- 13 Retirement Board prior to the effective date of this section
- 14 that provides for a period of time less than that enumerated in
- 15 71 Pa.C.S. § 5301(b.1) for State employees whose membership is
- 16 optional to elect membership in the State Employees' Retirement
- 17 System.
- 18 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
