AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in high schools, further providing for courses of study.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 1605 of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a subsection to read: Section 1605. Courses of Study.--* * * (c) (1) Beginning with those students graduating from a public high school at the end of the $2016-2017$ school year, and continuing in each school vear thereafter, a student who SUCCESSFULLY completes a course in computer science or <-information technology during grades nine through twelve shall be permitted to apply up to one credit earned for SUCCESSFUL <-completion of such course to satisfy the student's mathematics

1 or science credit requirement for graduation, provided, that the
2 governing body of the student's public high school shall have
3 discretion to determine the graduation credit requirement to
4 which the credit earned by the student shall be applied.
5 (2) As used in this subsection, "public high school" shall
6 mean a public school, including a school within a school
7 district, a charter school, a cyber charter school, a regional
8 charter school or an area vocational-technical school, that
9 offers twelfth grade.
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Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
