## AN ACT

Amending Title 23 (Domestic Relations) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in child protective services, further 2 providing for investigation of reports. Section 6368(d) of Title 23 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a paragraph to read: 8 § 6368. Investigation of reports. \* \* \* 9 10 Investigative actions. -- During the investigation, all of 11 the following shall apply: 12 \* \* \* 13 (5) The SUBJECT TO THE CONFIDENTIALITY REQUIREMENTS OF ◀ 14 SECTION 6339 (RELATING TO CONFIDENTIALITY OF REPORTS), THE 15 county agency shall have access to and shall review each record REQUESTED relating to the child, including medical 16 17 records, records of drug and alcohol treatment and school

- 2 6340.1 (relating to exchange of information) and 6346
- 3 (relating to cooperation of other agencies). NEITHER THE
- 4 CONSENT OF THE PARENTS NOR ANY OTHER RELEASE SHALL BE
- 5 REQUIRED TO PROVIDE THE RECORDS REQUESTED BY THE COUNTY
- 6 AGENCY. THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL ONLY APPLY TO THE EXTENT
- 7 PERMITTED BY FEDERAL LAW.

- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
