AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 4 laws relating thereto," providing for county consolidation of 5 school districts of all classes, except of the first class. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding an 10 11 article to read: 12 ARTICLE II-A 13 COUNTY CONSOLIDATION OF SCHOOL DISTRICTS 14 Section 201-A. Scope of article. 15 This article provides for county consolidation of school 16 districts. 17 Section 202-A. Definitions. 18 The following words and phrases when used in this article 19 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the context clearly indicates otherwise: 20

- 1 <u>"Department." The Department of Education of the</u>
- 2 Commonwealth.
- 3 "Identifying characteristics." Includes school name, school
- 4 <u>facility name</u>, school song, school mascot and any other indicia
- 5 <u>of school identity.</u>
- 6 <u>"School district." Includes school districts of all classes,</u>
- 7 except of the first class.
- 8 Section 203-A. Establishment of county school districts.
- 9 <u>(a) Establishment.--</u>
- 10 (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 224, all
- 11 <u>school districts shall be consolidated at the county level</u>
- 12 and be governed by a single county school board under section
- 13 <u>204-A.</u>
- 14 (2) The school board of each county shall appoint a
- 15 <u>single county superintendent for all schools within the</u>
- 16 <u>county consolidated under this article and may appoint a</u>
- 17 solicitor and such other appointees and employees as it may
- 18 deem proper in carrying out the provisions of this act.
- 19 (3) Each school consolidated under this article shall
- 20 maintain its own identifying characteristics in the new
- 21 <u>county district as long as it is operational.</u>
- 22 (b) Division.--In instances where the boundaries of a school
- 23 district encompass multiple counties, the department shall
- 24 divide the district and schools into the appropriate county
- 25 under section 205-A.
- 26 Section 204-A. Countywide school board.
- 27 <u>(a) Election.--At the first municipal election occurring</u>
- 28 more than 30 days subsequent to the formation of a countywide
- 29 school district under this article, a board of school directors
- 30 for the district shall be elected, as provided in this section.

- 1 (b) Directors.--
- 2 (1) When two or more school districts are combined into
- 3 a single county district under this article, the directors
- 4 <u>then in office in each component school district shall, until</u>
- 5 <u>the end of their respective terms, be directors of the newly</u>
- formed school district. Vacancies occurring in such incumbent
- 7 positions shall not be filled.
- 8 (2) At the first municipal election following the date
- 9 of establishment of the new county school district, three
- directors shall be elected by region for an initial two-year
- 11 term, three directors shall be elected by region for an
- 12 initial four-year term and three directors shall be elected
- by region for an initial six-year term. Terms of office shall
- 14 <u>begin on the first Monday of December following the election.</u>
- 15 For subsequent municipal elections, all school directors of
- the newly formed school district shall be elected by region
- for a term of six years.
- 18 (c) Regional election. -- Each school director shall be
- 19 elected by region, as determined by the department under section
- 20 <u>205-</u>A.
- 21 (d) Powers and duties of board. -- The new county school board
- 22 shall be classified based on countywide population as provided
- 23 under section 202 and shall have all the powers and duties of
- 24 other similarly classified school boards under this act.
- 25 Section 205-A. Departmental responsibilities.
- 26 Within one year of the effective date of this section, the
- 27 <u>department shall:</u>
- 28 (1) Distribute schools of school districts that
- 29 <u>encompass multiple counties into the county in which the</u>
- 30 individual school is located for the purpose of county

- 1 <u>consolidation under this article.</u>
- 2 (2) Divide each county into nine regions of equal
- 3 population, with consideration of current school district
- 4 lines. Each region shall elect one member to the county
- 5 <u>school board under section 204-A. The department shall</u>
- 6 <u>determine the initial term length of each region established</u>
- 7 <u>under subsection 204-A(b).</u>
- 8 (3) Provide advisors and legal counsel to school
- 9 <u>districts mandated to consolidate under this article.</u>
- 10 Section 206-A. Collective bargaining agreements.
- 11 The provisions of this article shall not be construed as
- 12 abrogating any provision of a collective bargaining agreement or
- 13 employment contract that exists prior to the effective date of
- 14 this section.
- 15 Section 2. This act shall take effect as follows:
- 16 (1) The addition of section 205-A of the act shall take
- 17 effect immediately.
- 18 (2) This section shall take effect immediately.
- 19 (3) The remainder of this act shall take effect in two
- 20 years.
