16	(1) In addition to any other penalty provided by law, a
17	person convicted of a violation of subsection (a) as the
18	result of a violation of 75 Pa.C.S. § 3732(a) (relating to

2	section 3732(a) may be sentenced to an additional term not to
3	exceed five years' confinement when the violation resulted in
4	death.
5	(2) The prosecution must indicate intent to proceed
6	under this section in the indictment or information which
7	commences the prosecution.
8	(3) The Pennsylvania Commission on Sentencing, pursuant
9	to 42 Pa.C.S. § 2154 (relating to adoption of guidelines for
10	sentencing), shall provide for a sentencing enhancement for
11	an offense under this section when the violation was the
12	result of a violation of 75 Pa.C.S. § 3732(a).

Aggravated assault by vehicle while using text-based 13 communications. 14 Any person who negligently causes serious bodily injury to another person as the result of a violation of section 3316 15 16 (relating to the prohibition of text-based communications) and who is convicted of violating section 3316 commits a felony of 17 18 the second degree when the violation is the cause of the injury. 19 Section 4. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
