Amending Titles 45 (Legal Notices) and 65 (Public Officers) of 1 the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in legal advertising, 2 providing for redundant advertising on Internet by political 3 subdivisions or municipal authorities; and, in open meetings, further providing for public notice. 5 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 8 Section 1. Title 45 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: § 308.1. Redundant advertising on Internet by political 10 11 subdivisions or municipal authorities. 12 (a) General rule. -- If a political subdivision or municipal 13 authority is required to advertise in a newspaper of general 14 circulation, the political subdivision or municipal authority may publish a redundant advertisement on the political 15 16 subdivision's or municipal authority's publicly accessible 17 Internet website in addition to the newspaper advertisement. (b) Effect of redundant advertisement. -- If the newspaper 18 advertisement fails to be timely published by the newspaper, the 19

- 1 advertisement shall be valid on the date that it was redundantly
- 2 <u>advertised on the political subdivision's or municipal</u>
- 3 <u>authority's publicly accessible Internet website.</u>
- 4 (c) Proof of publication. -- A political subdivision or
- 5 <u>municipal authority that holds a meeting under a redundant</u>
- 6 advertisement shall enter in the record a copy of the
- 7 <u>advertisement provided to the newspaper and proof that the</u>
- 8 political subdivision or municipal authority purchased the
- 9 <u>advertisement in a timely fashion. Proof shall consist of a</u>
- 10 receipt or any other similar communication showing the amount
- 11 paid and the date of the purchase.
- 12 (d) Definition. -- As used in this section, the term
- 13 "redundant advertisement" means a copy of the information
- 14 <u>submitted to a publication to be used as an advertisement in</u>
- 15 <u>accordance with the provisions of law.</u>
- 16 Section 2. Section 709 of Title 65 is amended by adding a
- 17 subsection to read:
- 18 § 709. Public notice.

- 20 (b.1) Redundant advertising on Internet by political
- 21 subdivisions or municipal authorities. -- Notwithstanding any
- 22 <u>other provision of this section, a political subdivision or</u>
- 23 municipal authority created by a political subdivision may
- 24 <u>satisfy the public notice requirement by using a redundant</u>
- 25 advertisement in accordance with 45 Pa.C.S. § 308.1 (relating to
- 26 redundant advertising on Internet by political subdivisions or
- 27 municipal authorities).

- 29 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
