Amending the act of May 22, 1951 (P.L.317, No.69), entitled "An 1 act relating to the practice of professional nursing; 2 providing for the licensing of nurses and for the revocation 3 and suspension of such licenses, subject to appeal, and for their reinstatement; providing for the renewal of such licenses; regulating nursing in general; prescribing penalties and repealing certain laws," further providing for 5 7 examinations and certificates. 8 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 11 Section 1. Section 5(c) of the act of May 22, 1951 (P.L.317, No.69), known as The Professional Nursing Law, is amended to 12 13 read: 14 Section 5. Examinations and Certificates .-- * * * The Board may admit to examination any person who has 15 16 satisfactorily completed a nursing education program for the preparation of registered professional nurses or an approved 17 dietetics-nutrition education program in a country or territory 18 not mentioned above [who has been licensed, registered, or duly 19 recognized there as a professional nurse, dietitian-

- 2 program is considered by the Board to be equal to that required
- 3 in this Commonwealth at the time such program was completed and
- 4 who meets the requirements of character and preliminary

- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
