AN ACT

- Amending Title 25 (Elections) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 1
- Statutes, in voter registration, providing for update of 2
- voter signature.
- The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 4
- hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 25 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- § 1331. Update of voter signature. 8
- 9 (a) Signature update authorized. -- Notwithstanding any other
- 10 law or regulation to the contrary, a registered elector may
- update the signature on file in the SURE system by completing a 11
- new voter registration application and submitting the 12
- 13 application to the commission in the county where the registered
- 14 elector resides in accordance with the requirements of this
- 15 chapter.
- 16 (b) Notification. -- The department and each commission shall:
- 17 (1) Include in correspondence concerned with voter

- 1 registration, other than postcard notifications and notices
- 2 <u>relating to eligibility, mailed to registered electors</u>
- 3 <u>information regarding when, where and how to update the</u>
- 4 <u>registered elector's signature, including how to obtain a</u>
- 5 <u>voter registration application.</u>
- 6 (2) Provide on the publicly accessible Internet websites
- 7 <u>maintained by a commission, the county election board and the</u>
- 8 <u>department information on how a registered elector can update</u>
- 9 <u>voter registration records maintained by the county or the</u>
- 10 Commonwealth.
- 11 (c) Absentee ballots.--All signature updates for use in
- 12 <u>verifying absentee ballots must be received by the appropriate</u>
- 13 <u>supervisor of elections no later than the date established for</u>
- 14 the acceptance of absentee ballots. The signature on that date
- 15 <u>is the signature that shall be used in verifying the signature</u>
- 16 <u>on the absentee ballot.</u>
- 17 (d) Publication of notice. -- At least once during each
- 18 primary and general election cycle, but no later than 90 days
- 19 before the date of the general election, each commission shall
- 20 publish in a newspaper of general circulation or other newspaper
- 21 in the county deemed appropriate by the county election board a
- 22 notice specifying when, where and how a registered elector may
- 23 update the registered elector's signature, including information
- 24 on how to obtain a voter registration application.
- 25 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
