AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
- act relating to the public school system, including certain
- provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto," in terms and courses of study,
- 6 providing for film approval by parent or guardian.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 11 section to read:
- 12 <u>Section 1528. Film Approval by Parent or Guardian.--(a)</u>
- 13 Prior to displaying, as part of its educational program, a
- 14 motion picture rated "R" or "NC-17" by the Motion Picture
- 15 Association of America, a school entity shall:
- 16 (1) Notify and obtain written consent from all parents or
- 17 guardians of all students enrolled in the course in which the
- 18 motion picture is to be displayed.
- 19 (2) If any parent or quardian of any student enrolled in the

- 1 course in which the motion picture is to be displayed objects or
- 2 <u>fails to provide written consent to the display of the motion</u>
- 3 picture, not display the motion picture during the current
- 4 <u>school year.</u>
- 5 (b) School entities shall retain consent forms for two years
- 6 <u>following their submission.</u>
- 7 (c) As used in this section, the term "school entity" means
- 8 any public school, intermediate unit, area vocational-technical
- 9 <u>school or charter school.</u>
- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
