1 2 3 4	Amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), entitled "An act to consolidate, editorially revise, and codify the public welfare laws of the Commonwealth," in public assistance, providing for the establishment of KEYS.
5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. The act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known
8	as the Public Welfare Code, is amended by adding a section to
9	read:
10	Section 405.1B. Establishment of KEYS(a) There is
11	established in the department a program which shall be known as
12	Keystone Education Yields Success (KEYS). KEYS shall be designed
13	to enable and to assist ELIGIBLE individuals receiving TANF or <
14	SNAP benefits to enroll in and pursue a certificate or degree
15	program within one of the Commonwealth's community colleges, A <
16	CAREER OR TECHNICAL SCHOOL REGISTERED WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF

1	EDUCATION or university within the Pennsylvania State System of	
2	Higher Education.	
3	(b) A KEYS recipient shall be permitted to count vocational	
4	education, including class time, clinicals, labs and study time	
5	as set by the community college, UNIVERSITY OR SCHOOL, toward	<
6	the recipient's core TANF work requirement for twenty-four	
7	months.	
8	(c) In accordance with KEYS and notwithstanding section	
9	405.1, the following requirements shall apply:	
10	(1) A recipient shall be enrolled in a AN APPROVED	<
11	degree or certificate program that will assist the recipient	
12	in securing a job that pays a family-sustaining wage.	
13	(2) A KEYS recipient may be granted a six-month	<
14	extension EXTENSIONS FOR SIX-MONTH PERIODS to complete the	<
15	certificate or degree program, provided:	
16	(i) the recipient is enrolled in a program that will	_
17	lead to a high-priority occupation, as defined in section	
18	1301 of the act of December 18, 2001 (P.L.949, No.114),	
19	known as the Workforce Development Act or a program the	
20	community college has certified meets the same criteria	
21	as a high-priority occupation;	
22	(ii) The recipient has maintained a 2.0 grade point	
23	average; and	
24	(iii) the recipient has made satisfactory progress	
25	toward completing the program, including, but not limited	_
26	to, completing all required developmental course work and	_
27	successfully completing an average of eight credits per	
28	semester.	
29	(d) A person who, without good cause, fails or refuses to	
30	comply with the terms and conditions of the KEYS program shall	

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1 <u>be terminated from the program.</u>

2	(e) The department shall IS AUTHORIZED TO promulgate	<
3	regulations to implement this section.	
4	(F) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL IMPLEMENT THIS SECTION IN	<
5	CONFORMITY WITH FEDERAL LAW.	

6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
