- 1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
- act relating to the public school system, including certain
- provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto," in preliminary provisions, providing
- for Defining a New Future for Pennsylvania Commission.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 11 section to read:
- 12 Section 128. Defining a New Future for Pennsylvania
- 13 Commission. -- (a) The Defining a New Future for Pennsylvania
- 14 Commission is established.
- 15 (b) The commission shall review and make findings and
- 16 recommendations related to the Commonwealth's education system
- 17 <u>for grades kindergarten through twelve.</u>
- 18 (c) The commission shall consist of the following members:
- 19 (1) The Governor or a designee.
- 20 (2) The Auditor General or a designee.

- 1 (3) The Attorney General or a designee.
- 2 (4) The Chancellor of the State System of Higher Education
- 3 or a designee.
- 4 (5) The Commissioner of Pennsylvania State Police or a
- 5 <u>designee</u>.
- 6 (6) The Executive Director of Pennsylvania Commission on
- 7 Crime and Delinguency or a designee.
- 8 <u>(7) The President of the Pennsylvania Commission for</u>
- 9 <u>Community Colleges or a designee.</u>
- 10 (8) The President pro tempore of the Senate or a designee.
- 11 (9) The Minority Leader of the Senate or a designee.
- 12 (10) The Speaker of the House of Representatives or a
- 13 <u>designee</u>.
- 14 (11) The Minority Leader of the House of Representatives or
- 15 a designee.
- 16 (12) Two students of a public school in this Commonwealth,
- 17 who are appointed by the Governor and whose term shall expire
- 18 upon the student's graduation, separation from the public school
- 19 or failure to maintain good academic standards at the public
- 20 school.
- 21 (13) A representative from a nonprofit organization that
- 22 represents a private elementary or secondary school in this
- 23 Commonwealth, who is appointed by the Speaker of the House of
- 24 Representatives.
- 25 (14) A representative from each of the following:
- 26 (i) The Pennsylvania School Boards Association.
- 27 (ii) The Pennsylvania State Education Association.
- 28 (iii) The Pennsylvania Coalition of Public Charter Schools.
- 29 <u>(iv) The Pennsylvania Principals Association.</u>
- 30 (v) The Pennsylvania Association of School Administrators.

- 1 (vi) The Pennsylvania Chamber of Business and Industry.
- 2 (vii) The Pennsylvania Association of Career and Technical
- 3 Administrators.
- 4 (viii) The Pennsylvania State Building and Construction
- 5 Trades Council, AFL-CIO.
- 6 (d) The commission shall hold its first meeting within sixty
- 7 (60) days of the effective date of this subsection regardless of
- 8 whether all of the commission members have been appointed to the
- 9 <u>commission</u>.
- 10 (e) The commission shall appoint a member to serve as
- 11 chairperson of the commission.
- 12 (f) The commission shall hold meetings at the call of the
- 13 <u>chairperson</u>.
- 14 (g) The members may not receive compensation for their
- 15 <u>services but shall be reimbursed for all necessary travel and</u>
- 16 other reasonable expenses incurred in connection with the
- 17 performance of their duties as members of the commission.
- 18 (h) The General Assembly shall provide administrative
- 19 support, meeting space and other assistance required by the
- 20 commission to carry out its duties under this section.
- 21 (i) The Department of Education shall provide the commission
- 22 with data, research and other information upon request.
- 23 (j) The commission shall issue a report containing findings
- 24 and recommendations not later than May 15, 2021, to the
- 25 <u>following:</u>
- 26 (1) The Governor.
- 27 (2) The President pro tempore of the Senate.
- 28 (3) The Majority Leader and Minority Leader of the Senate.
- 29 (4) The Speaker of the House of Representatives.
- 30 (5) The Majority Leader and Minority Leader of the House of

- 1 Representatives.
- 2 (6) The Appropriations Committee of the Senate.
- 3 (7) The Appropriations Committee of the House of
- 4 Representatives.
- 5 (8) The Education Committee of the Senate.
- 6 (9) The Education Committee of the House of Representatives.
- 7 (k) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 8 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless
- 9 <u>the context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 10 "Commission." The Defining a New Future for Pennsylvania
- 11 Commission established under this section.
- 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
