AN ACT

Amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), entitled "An act to consolidate, editorially revise, and codify the public welfare laws of the Commonwealth," in public assistance, 2 3 providing for payments for burial services; and abrogating a 4 regulation. 5 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 7 hereby enacts as follows: 8 Section 1. Article IV of the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Human Services Code, is amended by adding a subarticle to read: 10 11 (n) Burial Services Allowance 12 Section 494. Payments for Burial Services. (a) Payments. -- The department shall pay a burial or 13 cremation allowance in the amount of \$900 for the following: 14 15 (1) Individuals who received Supplemental Security 16 Income. 17 (2) Individuals who received cash benefits from the department prior to death. 18 (3) Individuals found eligible for cash assistance prior 19

- 1 to death.
- 2 (4) Residents of nursing homes who received Supplemental
- 3 Security Income or nursing home care payments prior to and
- 4 <u>continuously since January 1, 1973.</u>
- 5 (b) Supplement. -- This amount may be supplemented by the
- 6 <u>decedent's estate or another party in an amount not to exceed</u>
- 7 \$900, in accordance with the eligibility requirements of 55 Pa.
- 8 Code § 283.3 (relating to requirements for payment). Individuals
- 9 who die but did not apply for assistance shall be reviewed for
- 10 <u>eligibility to qualify for a grant allowance. If eligible, an</u>
- 11 <u>allowance shall be paid by the department.</u>
- 12 <u>(c) Expenses.--Separate payments totaling an amount not to</u>
- 13 exceed the amounts authorized in subsections (a) and (b) may be
- 14 made for funeral, cemetery and crematorium expenses.
- 15 <u>(d) Increase. -- The amounts specified in subsections (a) and</u>
- 16 (b) shall increase by \$50 each year for five consecutive years
- 17 after the effective date of this section.
- 18 Section 2. The provisions of 55 Pa. Code § 283.21 are
- 19 abrogated. All other provisions of 55 Pa. Code are abrogated
- 20 insofar as they are inconsistent with the addition of Subarticle
- 21 (n) of Article IV of the act.
- 22 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
