- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- Statutes, in general provisions relating to operation of
- vehicles, further providing for traffic-control signals and
- for expiration of automated red light enforcement systems
- 5 provisions.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Sections 3112(c), 3116(q) and 3117(r) of Title 75
- 9 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
- 10 § 3112. Traffic-control signals.
- 11 * * *
- 12 (c) Inoperable or malfunctioning signal. -- If a traffic-
- 13 control signal is out of operation or is not functioning
- 14 properly, including, but not limited to, a signal that uses

- 1 <u>inductive loop sensors</u>, or other automated technology, to detect
- 2 the presence of vehicles that fails to detect a vehicle,
- 3 vehicular traffic facing a:
- 4 (1) Green or yellow signal may proceed with caution as
- 5 indicated in subsection (a)(1) and (2).
- 6 (2) Red or completely unlighted signal shall stop in the
- 7 same manner as at a stop sign, and the right to proceed shall
- 8 be subject to the rules applicable after making a stop at a
- 9 stop sign as provided in section 3323 (relating to stop signs
- 10 and yield signs).
- 11 § 3116. Automated red light enforcement systems in first class
- 12 cities.

- 16 § 3117. Automated red light enforcement systems in certain
- 17 municipalities.

- 22 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
