## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), entitled "An
- act to consolidate, editorially revise, and codify the public
- 3 welfare laws of the Commonwealth," in departmental powers and
- duties as to licensing, further providing for refusal to
- issue license, revocation and notice; and imposing penalties.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Section 1026(b) and (c) of the act of June 13,
- 9 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Human Services Code, is
- 10 amended and the section is amended by adding a subsection to
- 11 read:
- 12 Section 1026. Refusal to Issue License; Revocation;
- 13 Notice.--\* \* \*
- 14 (b) The department shall refuse to issue a license, [or]
- 15 shall revoke a license, shall impose penalties or shall mandate
- 16 <u>corrective actions</u> for any of the following reasons:
- 17 (1) Violation of or non-compliance with the provisions of
- 18 this act or of regulations pursuant thereto;

- 1 (2) Fraud or deceit in obtaining or attempting to obtain a
- 2 license;
- 3 (3) Lending, borrowing or using the license of another, or
- 4 in any way knowingly aiding or abetting the improper granting of
- 5 a license;
- 6 (4) Gross incompetence, negligence or misconduct in
- 7 operating the facility;
- 8 (5) Mistreating or abusing individuals cared for in the
- 9 facility[.];
- 10 (6) Repeated MORE THAN THREE violations of a child's
- 11 specific rights as enumerated in 55 Pa. Code § 3800.32 (relating

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- 12 to specific rights); or
- 13 (7) A violation on the use of restraints as enumerated in
- 14 <u>55 Pa. Code § 3800.202 (relating to appropriate use of</u>
- 15 <u>restrictive procedures</u>)-;
- 16 (8) A VIOLATION OF THE STAFF HIRING, TRAINING AND
- 17 SUPERVISING REQUIREMENTS UNDER 55 PA. CODE § 3800.51 (RELATING
- 18 TO CHILD ABUSE AND CRIMINAL HISTORY CHECKS), 3800.52 (RELATING
- 19 TO STAFF HIRING, RETENTION AND UTILIZATION), 3800.53 (RELATING
- 20 TO DIRECTOR), 3800.54 (RELATING TO CHILD CARE SUPERVISOR),
- 21 3800.55 (RELATING TO CHILD CARE WORKER), 3800.56 (RELATING TO
- 22 EXCEPTIONS FOR STAFF QUALIFICATIONS), 3800.57 (RELATING TO
- 23 SUPERVISION) OR 3800.58 (RELATING TO STAFF TRAINING); OR
- 24 (9) A VIOLATION OF THE REQUIREMENT TO PROVIDE A DEPARTMENT
- 25 OF EDUCATION-APPROVED SCHOOL PROGRAM OR AN EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM
- 26 UNDER CONTRACT WITH A LOCAL PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT IN ACCORDANCE
- 27 WITH 55 PA. CODE § 3800.229 (RELATING TO EDUCATION).
- 28 (b.1) Penalties IN ADDITION TO REFUSING TO ISSUE A LICENSE <--
- 29 OR REVOKING A LICENSE, PENALTIES and corrective actions may
- 30 include imposing fines on a facility or mandating disciplinary

- 1 procedures against a staff member responsible for a violation.
- 2 (c) Whenever the department revokes or refuses to issue a
- 3 license, imposes penalties or mandates corrective actions, it
- 4 shall give written notice thereof by certified mail. Such notice
- 5 shall specify the reason for the refusal or revocation.
- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
