## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, in equipment standards, further providing for
- 3 unlawful activities.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 4107 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 8 § 4107. Unlawful activities.
- 9 \* \* \*
- 10 (b.2) Doors.--A vehicle shall be equipped with doors of a
- 11 type used as original equipment. The doors shall open and close
- 12 <u>securely unless the vehicle has been manufactured or modified to</u>
- 13 the extent that there is no roof or side. If a vehicle is
- 14 <u>designed by the manufacturer with removable doors for off-road</u>
- 15 use, the vehicle may be operated on roadways of this
- 16 <u>Commonwealth with doors removed as long as the owner of the</u>
- 17 vehicle notifies the motor vehicle insurer and carries

- 1 acknowledgment of that notification in the vehicle during such
- 2 operation. Notification shall be provided at the time of
- 3 application for motor vehicle insurance coverage and when
- 4 <u>coverage is renewed.</u> EXCEPT THAT THE VEHICLE MAY NOT BE:
- 5 (1) OPERATED ON ANY ROADWAY HAVING A SPEED LIMIT IN\_
- 6 EXCESS OF 55 MILES PER HOUR OR ON ANY LIMITED ACCESS HIGHWAY;
- 7 <u>OR</u>
- 8 (2) DRIVEN AT ANY SPEED IF A CHILD UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE
- 9 <u>IS A PASSENGER IN THE VEHICLE.</u>

- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 180 days. <--
