AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in reimbursements by Commonwealth and 5 between school districts, establishing the Emergency Basic 6 Education Subsidy Fund; and making an appropriation for the 7 8 purpose of emergency basic education funding. 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 10 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known 11 12 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a section to read: 13 Section 2599.8. Emergency Basic Education Subsidy Fund. -- (a) 14 15 The Emergency Basic Education Subsidy Fund is established as a 16 separate fund in the State Treasury. The money in the fund is 17 appropriated to carry out the provisions of this section. 18 (b) If a General Appropriation Act providing for a basic 19 education subsidy appropriation is not enacted by August 15 of any fiscal year, money is hereby appropriated to the Department 20

- 1 of Education for the purpose of emergency basic education
- 2 <u>funding</u>. To the extent the money is available, the State
- 3 Treasurer shall transfer the money to the Emergency Basic
- 4 Education Subsidy Fund in the total amount required to make
- 5 payments under subsection (d)(2). The transfers shall be up to
- 6 the dollar amounts and at the times as necessary to meet the
- 7 requirements of section 2517(c).
- 8 (c) If the Governor fails to certify revenue estimates under
- 9 <u>section 618 of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known</u>
- 10 as "The Administrative Code of 1929," prior to the date on which
- 11 <u>a basic education subsidy payment is due, the State Treasurer</u>
- 12 shall certify to the Secretary of the Budget each time a
- 13 <u>transfer is needed under subsection (b) that there is adequate</u>
- 14 <u>General Fund money to make the transfer.</u>
- (d) (1) The Secretary of Education shall draw a warrant on
- 16 the State Treasurer in favor of each district for the amount to
- 17 which the district is entitled, to meet each basic education
- 18 subsidy payment to the school districts under paragraph (2).
- 19 (2) Payments made to each school district shall be in the
- 20 same amount as provided in the previous year.
- 21 (e) Transfers provided under this section shall only be in
- 22 effect during the time in which no General Appropriation Act
- 23 providing for a basic education subsidy appropriation has been
- 24 enacted for the current fiscal year.
- 25 (f) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this act, the
- 26 board of school directors of each school district may reopen the
- 27 <u>school district's annual budget to reflect funding provided</u>
- 28 under this section.
- 29 Section 2. This act shall apply to fiscal years beginning
- 30 after June 30, 2019.

1 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
