AN ACT

- Designating a portion of State Route 422 in Lebanon County as the Officer Michael H. Wise II Memorial Highway.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Officer Michael H. Wise II Memorial Highway.
- 6 (a) Designation. -- The General Assembly finds and declares as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (1) Officer Michael H. Wise II was born and raised in
- 9 Lebanon County. He graduated in 1990 from Cedar Crest High
- 10 School and in 1993 from the Center for Emergency Medicine in
- 11 Pittsburgh.
- 12 (2) After serving as an EMT and paramedic in Lebanon,
- and later for six years in Pittsburgh, Officer Wise returned
- 14 to his roots in Lebanon County and settled in Myerstown.
- 15 (3) In 2002, Officer Wise fulfilled his lifelong dream

- of a career in law enforcement when he was hired as a police
- 2 officer by the City of Reading and graduated from the Reading
- 3 Police Academy.
- 4 (4) Officer Wise was tragically killed in the line of
- 5 duty on June 5, 2004.
- 6 (5) Officer Wise is survived by his wife, daughter,
- 7 parents, sister and extended family.
- 8 (6) Officer Wise's memory lives on through the Michael
- 9 H. Wise II Foundation.
- 10 (b) Designation. -- The section of State Route 422 in Lebanon
- 11 County from Ramona Road to the Lebanon/Berks County line is
- 12 hereby designated the Officer Michael H. Wise II Memorial
- 13 Highway.
- 14 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 15 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the highway to
- 16 traffic in both directions on the highway.
- 17 Section 2. Effective date.
- 18 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
