## A RESOLUTION

1 2 3 4 5	Recognizing the week of October 17 through 21, 2016, as "National Medical Assistants Recognition Week" in Pennsylvania in recognition of the quality care, support and vital services provided by medical assistants in this Commonwealth.
6	WHEREAS, The health of all Pennsylvanians depends upon
7	educated minds and trained hands; and
8	WHEREAS, The practice of modern medicine at the exacting
9	standards that society now enjoys and expects would become
10	impossible to achieve and maintain without the clinical and
11	administrative duties performed daily in physicians' offices,
12	clinics, laboratories and hospitals; and
13	WHEREAS, In the specialized world of health care, medical
14	assistants stand out as versatile professionals who operate as
15	multiskilled practitioners and perform a wide range of roles in
16	physicians' offices and other health care settings; and
17	WHEREAS, Medical assistants must work proficiently at a
18	multitude of administrative and clinical tasks; and
19	WHEREAS, Doctors view medical assistants as vital partners

who increase medical office productivity and provide efficient
and caring service to all patients; and

3 WHEREAS, Medical assistants may demonstrate their knowledge 4 and commitment to professionalism by earning the Certified 5 Medical Assistant (CMA) credential offered by the American 6 Association of Medical Assistants (AAMA) or the Registered 7 Medical Assistant credential offered by American Medical 8 Technologists (AMT); and

9 WHEREAS, Candidates who earn a CMA credential have 10 successfully completed a certification examination administered by the certifying board of the AAMA and enjoy increased respect 11 and recognition from their professional peers and employers; and 12 13 WHEREAS, The examination tests general medical knowledge, including terminology, anatomy, physiology, behavioral science, 14 15 medical law and ethics; administrative knowledge, including medical records management, collections and insurance 16 processing; and clinical knowledge, including examination room 17 18 techniques, medication preparation and administration,

19 pharmacology and specimen collection; and

20 WHEREAS, In this Commonwealth, the Pennsylvania Society of 21 Medical Assistants (PSMA) may assist medical assistants from 22 across this Commonwealth and is an affiliate of the AAMA; and 23 WHEREAS, As an affiliate, the PSMA works to provide medical 24 assistant professionals with education, certification, 25 credential acknowledgment, networking opportunities, scope-of-26 practice protection and advocacy for quality patient-centered

27 health care; and

28 WHEREAS, Both the AAMA and the AMT recognize the week of 29 October 17 through 21, 2016, as "Medical Assistants Recognition 30 Week"; and

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1 WHEREAS, The United States Bureau of Labor Statistics reports 2 that over 26,000 Pennsylvanians work as medical assistants in 3 this Commonwealth, forming an important part of the medical and 4 general labor force; therefore be it

5 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the week of October 17 through 21, 2016, as "National Medical 6 Assistants Recognition Week" in Pennsylvania in recognition of 7 8 the quality care, support and vital services provided by medical assistants in this Commonwealth; and be it further 9 10 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the 11 important service provided to the profession in this 12 Commonwealth by the Pennsylvania Society of Medical Assistants, 13 as well as the American Association of Medical Assistants and 14 American Medical Technologists; and be it further 15 RESOLVED, That members of the House of Representatives take

16 initiative to recognize local medical assistants working in 17 their communities for the important assistance they provide in 18 helping to heal and care for patients.

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
