A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing October 24, 2020, as "World Polio Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Rotary is a global network of neighbors, friends,
- 4 leaders and problem-solvers who unite and take action to create
- 5 lasting change in communities across the world; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The Rotary motto, "Service Above Self," inspires
- 7 members to provide humanitarian service, follow high ethical
- 8 standards and promote goodwill and peace in the world; and
- 9 WHEREAS, In 1985, Rotary launched PolioPlus and in 1988
- 10 helped establish the Global Polio Eradication Initiative, which
- 11 today includes the World Health Organization, the Centers for
- 12 Disease Control and Prevention, UNICEF, the Bill & Melinda Gates
- 13 Foundation and Gavi, the Vaccine Alliance, to immunize the
- 14 children of the world against polio; and
- WHEREAS, Polio cases have dropped by 99.9% since 1988 and the
- 16 world stands on the threshold of eradicating the disease; and
- 17 WHEREAS, To date Rotary has contributed more than \$2.1

- 1 billion and countless volunteer hours to protecting more than
- 2 2.5 billion children in 122 countries; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Rotary is working to raise an additional \$50 million
- 4 per year that would be leveraged for maximum impact by an
- 5 additional \$100 million annually from the Bill & Melinda Gates
- 6 Foundation; and
- WHEREAS, These efforts are providing much-needed operational
- 8 support, medical staff, laboratory equipment and educational
- 9 materials for health workers and parents; and
- 10 WHEREAS, In addition, Rotary has played a major role in
- 11 decisions by donor governments to contribute more than \$10
- 12 billion to the effort; and
- 13 WHEREAS, There are more than 1.2 million Rotary members in
- 14 more than 35,000 clubs throughout the world that sponsor service
- 15 projects to address such critical issues as poverty, disease,
- 16 hunger, illiteracy and the environment in their local
- 17 communities and abroad; therefore be it
- 18 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize October
- 19 24, 2020 as "World Polio Day" in Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 20 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives encourage all
- 21 citizens to join Rotary International in the fight for a polio-
- 22 free world.
