A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing the month of October 2018 as "Special Needs Law Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, It is important for parents and siblings of
- 4 individuals with special needs to plan for the care and
- 5 financial support of their child or sibling after their death;
- 6 and
- 7 WHEREAS, Public benefits such as Medicaid and Supplemental
- 8 Security Income do not cover all of the necessary expenses for
- 9 people with special needs; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Special needs planning can include establishing
- 11 special needs trusts, evaluating care options, advocating for
- 12 programs that benefit people with special needs and managing
- 13 public benefits such as Medicaid and Supplemental Security
- 14 Income; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Special needs law attorneys throughout the United
- 16 States perform a much-needed service for their communities by

- 1 informing people with special needs, their families and
- 2 caregivers about their legal options and protections; and
- 3 WHEREAS, The Special Needs Alliance (SNA) is a national
- 4 organization of attorneys who have devoted themselves to aiding
- 5 people with special needs and their loved ones in navigating
- 6 disability and public benefits law; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Individuals with disabilities and their families
- 8 depend on the SNA to find nearby attorneys who are experts in
- 9 disability law; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Protected Tomorrows was founded by Mary Anne Ehlert
- 11 to help those with special needs attain greater independence and
- 12 security; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Protected Tomorrows guides families through the
- 14 process of planning for the future of a family member with
- 15 special needs in order to alleviate anxieties and secure a
- 16 brighter future for individuals with special needs; and
- 17 WHEREAS, The National Academy of Elder Law Attorneys, Inc.
- 18 (NAELA) was founded in 1987 as a professional association of
- 19 attorneys who are devoted to utilizing their knowledge to aid
- 20 elderly people and people with special needs in navigating
- 21 important legal issues; and
- 22 WHEREAS, NAELA established October as "National Special Needs
- 23 Law Month" in order to promote the many resources available to
- 24 people with special needs and their families as they plan for
- 25 their financial future; and
- 26 WHEREAS, Many NAELA members are celebrating "National Special
- 27 Needs Law Month" by holding events in their communities to
- 28 inform the public about the options available for people with
- 29 special needs and their loved ones to safeguard their financial
- 30 future; and

- 1 WHEREAS, By recognizing "Special Needs Law Month," this
- 2 Commonwealth can raise awareness of the resources available for
- 3 people with special needs and their loved ones to plan for their
- 4 financial future; therefore be it
- 5 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
- 6 month of October 2018 as "Special Needs Law Month" in
- 7 Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 8 RESOLVED, That this Commonwealth express its full support for
- 9 all individuals with special needs as well as their loved ones.
