A RESOLUTION

- 1 Designating the week of November 5 through 9, 2018, as
- "Pennsylvania Education for Youth Experiencing Homelessness
- Awareness Week" and November 9, 2018, as "Red Shirt Day" in
- 4 Pennsylvania.
- 5 WHEREAS, In the 2016-2017 school year, 30,264 students in
- 6 Pennsylvania schools were homeless or without adequate housing;
- 7 and
- 8 WHEREAS, This represents an approximately 10% increase from
- 9 the previous school year; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The number of homeless students has risen 20% in the
- 11 last three years; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The purpose of this resolution is to educate the
- 13 public about the prevalence of youths experiencing homelessness,
- 14 the barriers that may prevent youths from attending school and
- 15 the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act that all schools must
- 16 comply with to overcome those barriers; and
- 17 WHEREAS, There are limited resources available to youths
- 18 experiencing homelessness, including the shortage of affordable
- 19 housing for displaced minors; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Homeless assistance service providers, as well as
- 2 community service opportunities for students and school service
- 3 organizations need public support; and
- 4 WHEREAS, There are many organizations committed to sheltering
- 5 and providing support services, meals and food supplies to
- 6 people experiencing homelessness, however, very few of these
- 7 services are specific to the needs of unaccompanied minors; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Many shelters will not accept a child under 18 years
- 9 of age without the company of a parent or guardian; and
- 10 WHEREAS, There is still a dire need for additional resources
- 11 to assist students experiencing homelessness to attend school
- 12 and be successful, including the basic needs of food, clothing
- 13 and educational supplies; and
- 14 WHEREAS, To show Statewide solidarity with children
- 15 experiencing homelessness and their educators, the House of
- 16 Representatives encourages Pennsylvanians to wear red on
- 17 November 9, 2018, for "Red Shirt Day"; and
- 18 WHEREAS, The purpose of "Pennsylvania Education for Youth
- 19 Experiencing Homelessness Awareness Week" is to encourage
- 20 schools, communities and individuals to plan for and support
- 21 assistance programs for youths experiencing homelessness as they
- 22 look to complete their education; therefore be it
- 23 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 24 week of November 5 through 9, 2018, as "Pennsylvania Education
- 25 for Youth Experiencing Homelessness Awareness Week" and November
- 26 9, 2018, as "Red Shirt Day" in Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 27 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urge all
- 28 residents to recognize that education is key to preventing
- 29 future homelessness and provides stability and support to youths
- 30 experiencing homelessness.
