A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing the month of November 2018 as "National Diabetes Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention
- 4 defines diabetes as a chronic disease that affects how an
- 5 individual's body turns food into energy; and
- 6 WHEREAS, When an individual has diabetes, the individual's
- 7 body either does not create enough insulin or is unable to
- 8 properly utilize its own insulin, resulting in an increased
- 9 level of blood sugar; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Individuals with diabetes can develop high blood
- 11 pressure which, when combined with uncontrolled levels of blood
- 12 sugar, can lead to serious health complications, including heart
- 13 disease, stroke, kidney disease, blindness, amputations of the
- 14 legs and feet and early death; and
- WHEREAS, In 2017, 30.3 million Americans, or 9.4% of the
- 16 population, had diabetes; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Approximately 1.25 million American children and
- 2 adults have type 1 diabetes; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Type 1 diabetes, previously known as juvenile
- 4 diabetes, is usually diagnosed in children and young adults; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Approximately 5% of individuals with diabetes have
- 6 type 1 diabetes; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Children and young adults can learn to manage type 1
- 8 diabetes with the help of insulin therapy and other treatments
- 9 and go on to live long, healthy lives; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Each year, 1.5 million Americans are diagnosed with
- 11 diabetes; and
- 12 WHEREAS, In the United States in 2015, 79,535 death
- 13 certificates listed diabetes as the underlying cause of death
- 14 and a total of 252,806 death certificates listed diabetes as an
- 15 underlying or contributing cause of death; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Diabetes is currently the seventh leading cause of
- 17 death in the United States; and
- 18 WHEREAS, In an effort to focus the nation's attention on this
- 19 ever-growing disease and its impact on millions of Americans,
- 20 November has been recognized as "National Diabetes Month"; and
- 21 WHEREAS, Advocates nationwide join together as a united
- 22 community during this month to raise awareness, promote ongoing
- 23 diabetes education and support those living with diabetes; and
- 24 WHEREAS, The American Diabetes Association is dedicated to
- 25 the research, education and advocacy necessary to improve the
- 26 lives of all individuals living with diabetes and its
- 27 potentially deadly consequences; and
- 28 WHEREAS, Continuing advocacy and healthy disease management
- 29 promotes the American Diabetes Association's vision of a life
- 30 free of diabetes and all of its burdens; therefore be it

- 1 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
- 2 month of November 2018 as "National Diabetes Month" in
- 3 Pennsylvania and join the movement to stop diabetes.
