A RESOLUTION

- Recognizing March 13, 2013, as "Pennsylvania Industrial Resource Centers Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, The seven Pennsylvania Industrial Resource Centers
- 4 (IRCs) located strategically throughout this Commonwealth and
- 5 their dedicated staff members help small and medium-sized
- 6 manufacturing enterprises respond to changing markets, new
- 7 technology and the competitive pressure of the global economy;
- 8 and
- 9 WHEREAS, Small and medium-sized manufacturers are critical to
- 10 the health and prosperity of the Pennsylvania economy and make
- 11 up 92% of the manufacturing establishments in this Commonwealth;
- 12 and
- 13 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania IRCs have provided sustained
- 14 performance through more than 30,000 projects for more than
- 15 9,200 firms since 1988; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania IRCs work with hundreds of closely

- 1 aligned professional manufacturing consultants that serve every
- 2 corner of this Commonwealth and draw resources from a strong
- 3 Statewide network and nationwide system; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Each year, Pennsylvania IRCs work with manufacturers
- 5 to innovate, grow profitable sales and create jobs in this
- 6 Commonwealth; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Many thousands of manufacturing CEOs use
- 8 Pennsylvania IRCs to keep up with the challenges of their global
- 9 markets, new innovations in products and processes, increasing
- 10 diversity in the work force, as well as the changing landscape
- 11 of government resources and regulations; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania IRCs play a liaison role among the
- 13 business community, economic development partners, elected
- 14 officials and manufacturing leaders and policymakers; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Collectively, Pennsylvania IRCs impact the regional
- 16 economy by improving profitability, creating jobs and
- 17 reinvesting in businesses; and
- 18 WHEREAS, The economic impact of services provided by
- 19 Pennsylvania IRCs over the last ten years equated to
- 20 \$7,395,185,729 in increased and retained sales, \$942,317,977 in
- 21 cost savings and \$1,443,369,811 in investments made; and
- 22 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania IRCs have supported the creation and
- 23 retention of 59,029 jobs in this Commonwealth over the last ten
- 24 years; and
- WHEREAS, In fiscal year 2011-2012, 780 of the hundreds of
- 26 manufacturers that the seven IRCs work with were independently
- 27 surveyed, reporting the impact of the IRCs to include
- 28 \$718,542,750 in sales increased and retained, \$90,358,032 in
- 29 savings, \$106,257,754 in investment and 4,955 jobs created and
- 30 retained; and

- 1 WHEREAS, The IRCs are the Commonwealth's only program
- 2 dedicated to manufacturing and making Pennsylvania a global
- 3 leader in manufacturing, which is the largest contributor to
- 4 gross State product, the employer of more than half a million
- 5 people in this Commonwealth and provides the family-sustaining,
- 6 high average annual wage of \$55,243; and
- WHEREAS, A highly advanced, globally competitive base of
- 8 manufacturers is critical to the future and economic growth of
- 9 Pennsylvania; therefore be it
- 10 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize March
- 11 13, 2013, as "Pennsylvania Industrial Resource Centers Day" in
- 12 Pennsylvania, salute the exemplary contributions that
- 13 Pennsylvania IRCs have made to the citizens and businesses of
- 14 this Commonwealth and extend best wishes for continued
- 15 leadership and service in the years to come.
