- 9 this Commonwealth; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Pulmonary rehabilitation is a broad program that
- 11 helps improve the well-being of people who have chronic
- 12 breathing problems; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Pulmonary rehabilitation can improve one's quality
- 14 of life and ability to function; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Observation of "Pulmonary Rehabilitation Week" calls
- 2 special attention to the dedicated professionals who promote the
- 3 dissemination of information about pulmonary disease, its
- 4 prevention and rehabilitation; and

- 6 Commonwealth and the strides made to conquer lung disease are
- 7 deserving of great recognition; therefore be it
- 8 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives hereby designate
