A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of April 2019 as "Sjogren's Syndrome Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania. 2
- WHEREAS, Sjogren's syndrome is a chronic autoimmune disease 3
- in which an individual's white blood cells attack their
- 5 moisture-producing glands; and
- 6 WHEREAS, As many as 4 million Americans are living with
- 7 Sjogren's syndrome; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Being a systemic disease, Sjogren's syndrome can
- affect all aspects of an individual's life; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Although its hallmark symptoms are dry eyes and dry
- 11 mouth, Sjogren's syndrome also causes serious complications
- 12 throughout the entire body, including fatigue, joint pain and
- 13 dysfunction of organs such as the kidneys, gastrointestinal
- system, blood vessels, lungs, liver, pancreas and the central 14
- nervous system; and 15
- 16 WHEREAS, Individuals with Sjogren's syndrome also have a

- 1 higher risk of developing lymphomas; and
- 2 WHEREAS, Millions of individuals around the world are
- 3 afflicted with Sjogren's syndrome; therefore be it
- 4 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 5 month of April 2019 as "Sjogren's Syndrome Awareness Month" in
- 6 Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 7 RESOLVED, That all Pennsylvanians be encouraged to learn more
- 8 about Sjogren's syndrome.
