A RESOLUTION

1 Designating the month of April 2015 as "Community Service
2 Appreciation Month" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, Community service and civic pride are core
4 principles of this Commonwealth; and

5 WHEREAS, Each year, Pennsylvanians donate millions of dollars
6 and volunteer hours to foundations and nonprofit corporations in
7 order to better our communities and this Commonwealth; and

8 WHEREAS, The Department of State has registered 11,055
9 charities in this Commonwealth; and

10 WHEREAS, According to the Corporation for National and
11 Community Service, almost 70% of Pennsylvanians engage in
12 informal volunteering, such as helping a neighbor or assisting a
13 senior citizen; and

14 WHEREAS, In 2013, 2.76 million Pennsylvanians volunteered 342

1 million hours of service for a cause, foundation or nonprofit
2 corporation; and

3 WHEREAS, The average dollar value for one hour of a
4 volunteer's time in Pennsylvania is \$21.94; and

5 WHEREAS, Annually, Pennsylvanians donate 32.1 volunteer hours
6 per capita; and

7 WHEREAS, Every volunteer in Pennsylvania deserves thanks and
8 recognition for their contributions; therefore be it

9 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
10 month of April 2015 as "Community Service Appreciation Month" in
11 Pennsylvania and congratulate all Pennsylvanians on their
12 participation in all forms of community service or volunteerism.
