A RESOLUTION

- 1 Urging the residents of this Commonwealth to support the
- efforts, programs, services and organizations that work to
- enhance research and awareness of undifferentiated
- 4 pleomorphic sarcoma, a type of soft tissue sarcoma.
- 5 WHEREAS, There are approximately 50 different types of soft
- 6 tissue sarcomas; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Sarcoma is a type of cancer that develops from
- 8 certain tissues like bone or muscle; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Soft tissue sarcomas can develop from soft tissues
- 10 like fat, muscle, nerves, fibrous tissues, blood vessels or deep
- 11 skin tissues; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Signs and symptoms of soft tissue sarcomas include
- 13 swelling or a lump that has grown over a period of time,
- 14 abdominal pain, blood in stool or vomit and black, tarry stools;
- 15 and
- 16 WHEREAS, Undifferentiated pleomorphic sarcoma, previously
- 17 known as malignant fibrous histiocytoma, is a type of soft
- 18 tissue sarcoma that is most common in older adults and is often

- 1 found in the arms or legs but can also form internally at the
- 2 back of the abdomen; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Although undifferentiated pleomorphic sarcoma tends
- 4 to grow locally, it can spread to distant sites in the body; and
- 5 WHEREAS, According to the American Cancer Society, it is
- 6 projected that approximately 12,750 new soft tissue sarcomas
- 7 will be diagnosed in the United States and approximately 5,270
- 8 Americans will die from soft tissue sarcomas in 2019; and
- 9 WHEREAS, While scientists do not know what causes most cases
- 10 of soft tissue sarcoma, they have identified risk factors that
- 11 make a person more likely to develop the disease, which include
- 12 radiation, certain family cancer syndromes, a damaged lymph
- 13 system and exposure to certain chemicals; and
- 14 WHEREAS, The main types of treatment for soft tissue sarcoma
- 15 are surgery, radiation, chemotherapy and targeted therapy;
- 16 therefore be it
- 17 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urge the
- 18 residents of this Commonwealth to support the efforts, programs,
- 19 services and organizations that work to enhance research and
- 20 awareness of undifferentiated pleomorphic sarcoma, a type of
