1 2 3 4 5	Recognizing the employees of the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission and the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation for their quick response and hard work to assist the Commonwealth of Massachusetts with snow removal due to repeated significant snow storms in February 2015.
6	WHEREAS, In early 2015, several massive storms resulting in
7	record snowfall hit the region of Boston, Massachusetts; and
8	WHEREAS, On February 11, 2015, the Commonwealth of
9	Massachusetts requested aid through the Emergency Management
10	Assistance Compact, or EMAC, coordinated through the
11	Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency; and
12	WHEREAS, The EMAC is a congressionally ratified mutual aid
13	compact that legally establishes a national system to facilitate
14	resources across state lines during an emergency disaster; and
15	WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission (PTC) and the
16	Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT)
17	collaboratively identified staff and equipment across this
18	Commonwealth and quickly mobilized emergency management

19 procedures; and

- 1 WHEREAS, On February 12 and 13, the PTC and PennDOT sent
- 2 crews and equipment to assist with snow removal from some of the
- 3 small towns and boroughs in the greater Boston area; and
- 4 WHEREAS, The PTC committed 10 equipment operators, two
- 5 mechanics and two assistant foremen with five dump trucks and
- 6 five backhoes from PTC operations across this Commonwealth; and
- 7 WHEREAS, PennDOT officials enlisted 18 plow and mechanic
- 8 trucks, three backhoes and three lowboy tractor trailers to
- 9 transport backhoes from PennDOT's Montoursville, King of Prussia
- 10 and Uniontown-based regions, as well as more than 27 operators
- 11 and other staff from those same PennDOT regions and its
- 12 Clearfield-based office; and
- 13 WHEREAS, PTC and PennDOT employees went above and beyond the
- 14 call of duty, leaving their own homes and families for extended
- 15 periods of time to provide superior customer service and to
- 16 ensure the safety of others in the Commonwealth of
- 17 Massachusetts; and
- 18 WHEREAS, PTC and PennDOT employees also continued to deliver
- 19 exemplary service to the citizens of this Commonwealth in
- 20 relation to winter operations, remaining committed to the safety
- 21 of travelers in-State; therefore be it
- 22 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
- 23 employees of the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission and the
- 24 Pennsylvania Department of Transportation for their quick
- 25 response and hard work to assist the Commonwealth of
- 26 Massachusetts with snow removal due to repeated significant snow
- 27 storms in February 2015; and be it further
- 28 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to
- 29 the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission and Pennsylvania Department
- 30 of Transportation Central Offices to share with their respective
