A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commemorating the 100th anniversary of the Pennsylvania Public 2 School Employees' Retirement System on July 1, 2019.
- 3 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Public School Employees' Retirement
- 4 System (PSERS) was established July 18, 1917, and began
- 5 operations in 1919, with an initial membership of 37,503; and
- 6 WHEREAS, PSERS currently provides for retirement benefits to
- 7 more than half a million active and retired public school
- 8 employees; and
- 9 WHEREAS, PSERS is the 15th largest state-sponsored public
- 10 pension fund in the nation; and
- 11 WHEREAS, PSERS assets have grown from \$6 billion in 1982 to
- 12 approximately \$56.6 billion as of September 30, 2018; and
- WHEREAS, In fiscal year 2018, PSERS distributed \$6.6 billion
- 14 in annual pension funds to retirees; and
- 15 WHEREAS, From the distribution in 2018, \$6 billion went
- 16 directly to residents of this Commonwealth; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Distributions made directly to Pennsylvanians
- 18 stimulate economic activity throughout this Commonwealth,

- 1 equating to an economic impact of over \$12.7 billion annually;
- 2 and
- 3 WHEREAS, PSERS investments in the Commonwealth support over
- 4 65,000 jobs that paid \$3.4 billion in wages and salaries in
- 5 2018; and
- 6 WHEREAS, As an institution, PSERS values reliability,
- 7 dependability and dedication and works diligently so members can
- 8 rely on PSERS to provide the benefits and services that they
- 9 have earned; and
- 10 WHEREAS, PSERS provides a steady monthly income funded by
- 11 employees making mandatory contributions into the system
- 12 throughout their careers; therefore be it
- 13 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives commemorate the
- 14 100th anniversary of the Pennsylvania School Employees'
- 15 Retirement System on July 1, 2019.
