A RESOLUTION

- Designating April 30, 2019, as "Life Sciences Day" in 1 Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth has a rich history of research and
- 4 innovation, including being home to the nation's first hospital,
- medical school and college of pharmacy; and 5
- 6 WHEREAS, Many of the world's greatest medical breakthroughs
- have come from research conducted in this Commonwealth; and 7
- 8 WHEREAS, Vaccines for blood-based hepatitis B, rubella,
- 9 rotavirus and polio, the first FDA-approved gene therapy for a
- 10 genetic disease, as well as the first simultaneous heart, liver
- 11 and kidney transplant were all developed in this Commonwealth,
- 12 fundamentally reshaping health care and improving the lives of
- 13 millions of people worldwide; and
- 14 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth has geographic access to
- 15 regulatory agencies in Washington, DC, and financial markets in
- 16 New York City and unique talent from its numerous higher
- 17 education institutions; and
- 18 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth has a remarkable legacy of

- 1 innovative leaders such as Dr. M. Stephen "Doc" Heilman, the
- 2 late Dr. Jonas Salk, Dr. Hubert J.P. Schoemaker and Frank
- 3 Baldino, Jr., Ph.D.; and
- 4 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth is home to two of the top five
- 5 recipients of National Institutes of Health funding research
- 6 institutions, the University of Pennsylvania and the University
- 7 of Pittsburgh, as well as the nation's largest research
- 8 institution dedicated to women's health and reproductive
- 9 biologies, Magee-Women's Research Institute; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The life sciences industry is a cornerstone of this
- 11 Commonwealth's economic future, directly employing 112,000
- 12 workers with an economic impact from wages alone totaling \$11
- 13 billion and total industry annual impact of over \$88 billion;
- 14 and
- 15 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth is uniquely positioned as the home
- 16 of a diverse and robust life sciences ecosystem in one location
- 17 through seed capital, discovery research, emerging industry,
- 18 contract laboratory organizations, medical devices and
- 19 diagnostics companies, mature biopharmaceutical industry and
- 20 global pharmaceuticals; therefore be it
- 21 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate April
- 22 30, 2019, as "Life Sciences Day" in this Commonwealth and
- 23 encourage all Pennsylvanians to learn more about this exciting,
- 24 vibrant and innovative industry.
