## A RESOLUTION

Designating the month of May 2019 as "Cancer Caregivers Recognition Month" in Pennsylvania and honoring the vital 1 2 role caregivers play in the lives of cancer patients. 3 4 WHEREAS, The American Cancer Society estimates that there will be 79,890 new cases of cancer diagnosed in this 5 6 Commonwealth in 2019; and WHEREAS, Known as family caregivers or lay caregivers, unpaid 7 caregivers are usually spouses, partners or adult children, with 8 close friends, coworkers and neighbors often filling this role 9 when family members are not nearby or are unavailable; and 10 11 WHEREAS, Caregivers are an important part of the health care 12 team and provide a complex array of support tasks that extend 13 across physical, psychological, spiritual and emotional domains; 14 and 15 WHEREAS, A family caregiver's work can be a full-time job,

often forcing the caregiver to quit their paying occupation to meet the demands of providing care to those with cancer; and WHEREAS, Caring for an individual with cancer can be very stressful and exhausting, requiring emotional, spiritual and physical strength; and

6 WHEREAS, The risks associated with the emotional toll taken 7 on a cancer caregiver can include a decrease in quality of life, 8 depression, impaired immunity, heart disease and early death; 9 and

10 WHEREAS, Caregiver stress may continue after the patient's treatment ends as roles change again, and some caregivers 11 12 experience problems adjusting after treatment is completed; and 13 WHEREAS, The support of family, friends, employers, coworkers 14 and the community is key to assist caregivers in taking care of 15 themselves both during caregiving and after caregiving ends; and 16 WHEREAS, Many careqivers find satisfaction in providing care for a loved one with cancer as a means of expressing their love 17 18 and respect for that individual; and

19 WHEREAS, Many cancer patients are deeply grateful to their 20 caregivers for the love and dedication, weathering the 21 challenges and setbacks of cancer treatment and sharing the 22 triumphs with them; therefore be it

23 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the 24 month of May 2019 as "Cancer Caregivers Recognition Month" in 25 Pennsylvania; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives honor all cancer caregivers for their strength, love and unwavering support for their loved ones with cancer and urge all residents to show their support and appreciation for cancer caregivers across this Commonwealth.

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
