- 1 Honoring Rande Stottlemyer, head wrestling coach, for 35 years
- of excellence in coaching student athletes at the University
- of Pittsburgh.
- WHEREAS, Rande Stottlemyer was a three-time All-American
- 5 wrestler for the Panthers from 1974 to 1978; and
- 6 WHEREAS, In 1978, following his graduation from the
- 7 University of Pittsburgh, Mr. Stottlemyer was appointed
- 8 assistant coach and the following year became the university's
- 9 head wrestling coach; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Mr. Stottlemyer compiled a record of 304-230-12 over
- 11 34 seasons; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Mr. Stottlemyer is the winningest coach in
- 13 University of Pittsburgh wrestling history; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Mr. Stottlemyer is a five-time Eastern Wrestling
- 15 League Coach of the Year; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Mr. Stottlemyer has coached 56 Eastern Wrestling
- 2 League individual champions, 33 All-Americans and three national
- 3 champions; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Mr. Stottlemyer retires at the top of his coaching
- 5 tenure, having led the Panthers to three Eastern Wrestling
- 6 League regular-season and three Eastern Wrestling League
- 7 tournament titles in the last four years; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The Panthers Wrestling Team under Mr. Stottlemyer
- 9 has been ranked No. 15 nationally in his last two seasons;
- 10 therefore be it
- 11 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives honor Rande
- 12 Stottlemyer, retiring head wrestling coach of the University of
- 13 Pittsburgh, for 35 years of excellence in coaching student
- 14 athletes and his team's achievements within the sport and wish
- 15 him well in retirement.
