## A RESOLUTION

- Condemning the global persecution of Christians and calling on 2 world leaders to implement policies that protect the religious liberty of Christians and all other faiths within 3 their borders. 4 5 WHEREAS, Persecution comes in many forms including discrimination, loss of basic fundamental rights, violence, 6 torture and execution; and 8 WHEREAS, Christians are currently being persecuted in over 50 countries for their faith; and 10 WHEREAS, One-hundred million Christians were persecuted in 11 2012 alone; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The United States Commission on International
- 13 Religious Freedom finds systematic persecution of religious
- 14 minorities, which includes many Christians, to be a global
- 15 problem that is not contained in one specific region of the
- 16 world; and
- 17 WHEREAS, In Belarus, government permitting and regulation of

- 1 religious communities has restricted the ability of Christians
- 2 to worship freely; and
- 3 WHEREAS, In Cuba, pastors have been beaten and detained for
- 4 public preaching; and
- 5 WHEREAS, In China, more than 1,000 Christians were detained
- 6 in 2012 for their religious convictions; and
- WHEREAS, In North Korea, approximately 6,000 Christians are
- 8 being held in just one of the country's many labor camps and are
- 9 victims of constant abuse; and
- 10 WHEREAS, In Burma, Christians are subject to extrajudicial
- 11 killings, sexual violence and forced labor; and
- 12 WHEREAS, In Egypt, Christian-owned homes, businesses and
- 13 churches have been subject to violence and vandalism, causing
- 14 Christian families to abandon their homes; and
- 15 WHEREAS, In Iran, Christian converts face severe
- 16 discrimination, arbitrary arrests, executions and extrajudicial
- 17 killings; and
- 18 WHEREAS, In Sudan, paramilitary soldiers target Christians
- 19 for executions and arrests; therefore be it
- 20 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives condemn the
- 21 global persecution of Christians and call on world leaders to
- 22 implement policies that protect the religious liberty of
- 23 Christians and all other faiths within their borders.
