A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life and achievements of former State
2 Representative Fred Noye.

3 WHEREAS, Former State Representative Fred Noye passed away on
4 February 24, 2024; and

5 WHEREAS, Mr. Noye was born May 13, 1946, in Duncannon; and

6 WHEREAS, Mr. Noye graduated from Susquenita High School in
7 1964 and then attended Harrisburg Area Community College and
8 Mansfield State Teachers College before receiving his master's
9 degree in education from Shippensburg University of Pennsylvania
10 in 1970; and

11 WHEREAS, While serving his community as a teacher, Mr. Noye
12 was the chairman of the Young Republicans of Perry County and
13 the Penn Township Republican Committee; and

14 WHEREAS, Mr. Noye was elected to the Pennsylvania House of
15 Representatives, representing Cumberland, Juniata and Perry
16 Counties, in 1973; and

17 WHEREAS, Mr. Noye served nine more consecutive terms and
18 during his tenure was elected as Majority Caucus Chair and

1 Minority Caucus Chair and was appointed to the Legislative
2 Budget and Finance Committee, Joint State Government Commission
3 and the Select Committee to Study the Feasibility of a
4 Harrisburg University; and

5 WHEREAS, Mr. Noye continued being an active member of his
6 community until his death; and

7 WHEREAS, Mr. Noye was loved by many, including his parents,
8 Charles and Marie Noye of Duncannon, his wife of 50 years, Debra
9 Kay (Freeman) Noye, his son Jeremy Wade Noye and his
10 grandchildren, Grace, Katarina and Valentina, his son Andrew
11 Charles Noye and his grandchildren, Edyn, Isla, Jack and Gracie
12 and his great-grandchildren, Georgia and Morgan; therefore be it
