| 3 | WHEREAS, Behavior analysis is a natural science, distinct |
| 4 | from psychology, in which the interaction between environmental |
| 5 | variables and behavior is studied, with that knowledge utilized |
| 6 | to produce effective and efficient methods to teach and increase |
| 7 | socially significant behaviors while reducing harmful behaviors; |

| 9 | WHEREAS, B. F. Skinner, a native of Pennsylvania, established |
| 10 | behavior analysis as the experimental study of how learning |
| 11 | occurs through the interaction between environmental variables |
| 12 | and behavior over time; and |
| 13 | WHEREAS, The field of behavior analysis contains more than 80 |
| 14 | years of experimental research and more than 60 years of applied |
| 15 | research demonstrating the relationships between environment and |
| 16 | behavior as well as interventions that create socially |
| 17 | significant improvements in an individual's life; and |

1 WHEREAS, The field of behavior analysis has research evidence 2 that shows effective and efficient behavior-change procedures 3 can dramatically affect any area of human behavior, including 4 mental health, education, health and wellness, weight loss 5 programs, medication and medical treatment adherence, 6 gerontology, business management, business leadership, training 7 and supervision; and

8 WHEREAS, The field of behavior analysis has research evidence that shows effective and efficient behavior-change procedures 9 10 for a wide range of mental health disorders; and 11 WHEREAS, Applied behavior analysis is widely recognized as 12 the most effective treatment for children and adults with autism 13 spectrum disorder and intellectual and developmental 14 disabilities, with more than 50 years of scientific research 15 establishing its effectiveness in producing socially significant 16 behavior change; and

WHEREAS, The American Academy of Pediatrics and the Surgeon General of the United States have endorsed the use of applied behavior analysis in the treatment of autism spectrum disorder; and

21 WHEREAS, Behavior analysts and behavior analytic professionals engage in experimental and applied research, 22 23 service delivery of interventions based on research and serve as 24 trainers, supervisors and leaders within organizations engaging 25 in research and application of behavior-change procedures; and 26 WHEREAS, On a daily basis, behavior analysts oversee treatment programming for individuals and conduct assessment of 27 28 skills and skill deficits, assessment of unsafe or unhealthy behavior, development of behavior-change procedures, training of 29 30 staff in implementation of behavior-change procedures,

collection of behavior data to monitor the effectiveness of
treatment programming, ongoing supervision of staff providing
behavior-change programming and collaboration with other
providers and individuals and their families to ensure treatment
success; and

6 WHEREAS, There are currently numerous board certified 7 behavior analysts and behavior analytic professionals in this 8 Commonwealth, including 82 doctoral-level board certified 9 behavior analysts, 1,017 board certified behavior analysts, 28 10 board certified assistant behavior analysts and 229 registered 11 behavior technicians; therefore be it

12 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate June 13 12, 2017, as "Behavior Analyst Appreciation Day" in

14 Pennsylvania.
