## A RESOLUTION

1 2 3 4	Designating the week of September 10 through 16, 2017, as "Idiopathic Pulmonary Fibrosis Research and Awareness Week" in Pennsylvania to increase awareness and understanding of idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis.
5	WHEREAS, Idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis is a debilitating and
6	generally fatal disease marked by progressive scarring of the
7	lungs causing an irreversible loss of the lung tissue's ability
8	to transport oxygen; and
9	WHEREAS, Idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis progresses quickly,
10	often causing disability or death within three to five years;
11	and
12	WHEREAS, Idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis is the most common
13	form of interstitial lung disease; and
14	WHEREAS, There is no proven cause of idiopathic pulmonary
15	fibrosis, and it is often misdiagnosed or under diagnosed; and
16	WHEREAS, Idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis is five times more
17	common than cystic fibrosis and Lou Gehrig's disease yet the

1 disease remains virtually unknown and receives a fraction of the 2 research funding; and

3 WHEREAS, More than 132,000 United States citizens have 4 idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis and approximately 50,000 new cases 5 are diagnosed each year; and

6 WHEREAS, As many as 40,000 people die each year due to 7 idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis, the same number as breast cancer; 8 and

9 WHEREAS, Approximately 7,000 Pennsylvanians suffer from 10 idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis; and

11 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth has become a leader in research 12 and treatment of idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis, with more than 13 15% of all lung transplants in the United States performed in 14 Pennsylvania hospitals; and

15 WHEREAS, A need has been identified to increase research, 16 awareness and detection of idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis; 17 therefore be it

18 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the 19 week of September 10 through 16, 2017, as "Idiopathic Pulmonary 20 Fibrosis Research and Awareness Week" in Pennsylvania to 21 increase awareness and understanding of idiopathic pulmonary 22 fibrosis.

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
