A RESOLUTION

Recognizing the week of August 1 through 7, 2019, as "World Breastfeeding Week" in Pennsylvania and supporting breastfeeding as a way to enhance the well-being of all 3 individuals worldwide. 4 WHEREAS, "World Breastfeeding Week" was established and is 5 annually recognized by the World Alliance for Breastfeeding Action; and 7 8 WHEREAS, "World Breastfeeding Week" highlights the critical 9 importance of breastfeeding children across the globe; and 10 WHEREAS, This year's theme is "Empower Parents and Enable 11 Breastfeeding"; and 12 WHEREAS, The theme seeks to protect, promote and support 13 breastfeeding through: 14 Parental social protection policies and legislation. (1)15 Parent-friendly workplaces in both formal and (2) 16 informal sectors.

- 4 WHEREAS, Breastfeeding provides ideal nutrition for infants
- 5 and contributes to their healthy growth and development; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Research suggests that breastfed babies have a lower
- 7 risk of acquiring the following:
- 8 (1) Asthma.
- 9 (2) Childhood leukemia.
- 10 (3) Childhood obesity.
- 11 (4) Ear infections.
- 12 (5) Lower respiratory infections.
- 13 (6) Sudden infant death syndrome (SIDS).

- 16 WHEREAS, Breastfeeding also improves the health and healing
- 17 of mothers following childbirth and leads to a lower risk of
- 18 acquiring the following:
- 19 (1) Type 2 diabetes.
- 20 (2) Certain types of breast cancer.
- 21 (3) Ovarian cancer;

- 23 WHEREAS, Breastfeeding also leads to a more productive
- 24 workforce as mothers who breastfeed miss less time from work to
- 25 care for sick infants than mothers who feed their infants

- 27 WHEREAS, Breastfeeding is a vital part of sustainable
- 28 development and a key contributor to the survival and health of
- 29 infants and mothers; and
- 30 WHEREAS, Active support, encouragement and guidance is
