## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Urging the Governor to amend the Governor's Code of Conduct as 2 it relates to an Executive Branch employee gift ban.
- 3 WHEREAS, On January 20, 2015, the Governor issued Executive
- 4 Order 2015-01; and
- 5 WHEREAS, The executive order amends the Governor's Code of
- 6 Conduct by adding provisions to prohibit employees, appointees
- 7 and officials of the Executive Branch from soliciting or
- 8 accepting, for personal use, gifts from certain persons; and
- 9 WHEREAS, As a result of these provisions, the Governor's Code
- 10 of Conduct is unreasonable when applied to certain activities of
- 11 nonprofit organizations and civic groups; therefore be it
- 12 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urge the Governor
- 13 to amend the Governor's Code of Conduct as it relates to an
- 14 Executive Branch employee gift ban by permitting an employee,
- 15 appointee or official of the Executive Branch to accept and, if
- 16 out-of-pocket costs are incurred, to be reimbursed for the
- 17 following items offered to the employee, appointee or official
- 18 by a nonprofit organization or civic group:

- 1 (1) plaques, trophies and other items that are
  2 substantially commemorative in nature and of minimal value;
  3 and
- 4 (2) light food or refreshments, such as hors d'oeuvres, 5 provided in a group setting and intended for consumption by 6 the employee, appointee or official, as well as other 7 individuals.
