A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of November 2017 as "Assistive Technology Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, An assistive technology device is any item, piece of
- 4 equipment or product system, whether acquired commercially,
- 5 modified or customized, that is used to increase, maintain or
- 6 improve the functional capabilities of individuals with
- 7 disabilities or older individuals; and
- 8 WHEREAS, An assistive technology service is any service that
- 9 directly assists an individual in the selection, acquisition or
- 10 use of an assistive technology device; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Assistive technology devices and services are tools
- 12 that empower individuals to control their lives and their
- 13 futures through the ability to work, attend school, play and
- 14 live in the community of their choice; and
- WHEREAS, Pennsylvanians of all ages with disabilities may
- 16 need assistive technology devices and services to live

- 1 independently and productively as well as to participate fully
- 2 in their communities; and
- 3 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth is a leader in the development and
- 4 implementation of assistive technology programs for residents
- 5 with disabilities and older residents; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Working in conjunction with organizations such as
- 7 the Pennsylvania Assistive Technology Foundation, the
- 8 Commonwealth provides valuable information and support,
- 9 financial education and financing for the purchase of assistive
- 10 technology devices and services; therefore be it
- 11 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 12 month of November 2017 as "Assistive Technology Awareness Month"
- 13 in Pennsylvania.
