## A RESOLUTION

- Recognizing the week of September 8 through 14, 2019, as 2 "Historically Black Colleges and Universities Week" in Pennsylvania. 3 WHEREAS, Historically, African-American individuals took 4 great risks and sacrificed much to establish a safe learning environment to achieve significant advancements across the 7 United States; and 8 WHEREAS, Since the early 1800s, historically black colleges and universities (HBCUs) were established to serve the educational needs of African Americans; and 10 11 WHEREAS, HBCUs created supportive and empowering educational 12 environments for young people from diverse backgrounds; and 13 WHEREAS, Today, there are more than 100 HBCUs in the United 14 States, including public and private institutions and
- 16 WHEREAS, At a time when many schools barred their doors to

professional schools of law and medicine; and

African Americans, HBCUs offered the best, and often the only,

- 1 opportunity for a higher education; and
- 2 WHEREAS, HBCUs have continued to be a vital resource in the
- 3 nation's educational system and have made countless
- 4 accomplishments to the advancement of their students and the
- 5 nation at large; and
- 6 WHEREAS, For generations, spanning more than 180 years, HBCUs
- 7 have contributed to the growth of African-American individuals
- 8 in the areas of academia, technology, business, law and
- 9 government; and
- 10 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth is home to two HBCUs, Cheyney
- 11 University of Pennsylvania and Lincoln University; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Cheyney University of Pennsylvania, founded by
- 13 Richard Humphreys in 1837, is the oldest of the HBCUs in the
- 14 country; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Lincoln University was founded in 1854 by John
- 16 Miller Dickey and his wife, Sarah Emlen Cresson; and
- 17 WHEREAS, These institutions have a mission to uphold their
- 18 tradition of academic excellence as they strive to maintain
- 19 their commitment to provide an education for students of diverse
- 20 backgrounds; and
- 21 WHEREAS, "Historically Black Colleges and Universities Week"
- 22 is a source of accomplishment and great pride for the African-
- 23 American community as well as the entire nation; therefore be it
- 24 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
- 25 week of September 8 through 14, 2019, as "Historically Black
- 26 Colleges and Universities Week" in Pennsylvania.
