## A RESOLUTION

1 2	Designating the month of September 2019 as "Benzodiazepine Addiction Recovery Month" in Pennsylvania.
3	WHEREAS, Benzodiazepines, more commonly know as "benzos," are
4	a prescription sedative class of drugs that can be highly
5	addictive; and
6	WHEREAS, More than 30% of overdoses involving opioids also
7	involve benzodiazepines; and
8	WHEREAS, Benzodiazepines raise the level of the inhibitory
9	neurotransmitter GABA in the brain, which helps relax the
10	nervous system; and
11	WHEREAS, Common examples of benzodiazepines are diazepam
12	(Valium), alprazolam (Xanax) and clonazepam (Klonopin), which
13	can be prescribed for anxiety, insomnia, alcohol withdrawal,
14	seizure control, muscle relaxation, inducing amnesia for
15	difficult procedures and given prior to anesthetic; and
16	WHEREAS, Benzodiazepine abuse is very common due to
17	widespread availability of the drugs, which can lead to toxic
18	effects and accidental overdoses; and

WHEREAS, Symptoms of benzodiazepine abuse include weakness,
 blurred vision, drowsiness, poor judgment or thinking, mood
 changes and other risk-taking behaviors; and

WHEREAS, There are a wide range of other symptoms an
individual facing benzodiazepine addiction may experience
including mania, slurred speech, panic attacks, impaired
coordination, fatigue, vertigo, hostility and increased risk of
suicide; and

9 WHEREAS, An individual can quickly develop a tolerance to 10 benzodiazepines, thus requiring more of the drug to feel the 11 same effects, allowing addiction to develop in as little as a 12 few weeks; and

13 WHEREAS, Benzodiazepine addiction recovery can be a long 14 process, involving physical stability, substance withdrawal, 15 trauma treatment, peer support, healthy coping mechanisms, 16 rebound anxiety, co-occurring disorders, family and aftercare; 17 and

18 WHEREAS, An effective recovery is possible given the proper 19 support and communication between all involved parties; 20 therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the month of September 2019 as "Benzodiazepine Addiction Recovery Month" in Pennsylvania and encourage all Pennsylvanians to learn more about the adverse effects of benzodiazepine addiction.
