A RESOLUTION

1 2 3	Recognizing the week following the second Monday in October as "Indigenous Peoples Week" and the month of October 2019 as "Indigenous Peoples Month" in Pennsylvania.
4	WHEREAS, In the United States, Native American Indians,
5	Alaska Natives and Native Hawaiians are recognized as indigenous
6	peoples; and
7	WHEREAS, Indigenous peoples have inhabited the land that is
8	now known as Pennsylvania and the United States since time
9	immemorial; and
10	WHEREAS, The original inhabitants of Pennsylvania include the
11	Erie, Iroquois, Lenape, Munsee, Shawnee and Susquehannock Native
12	American Indian tribes; and
13	WHEREAS, Of the 50 states, this Commonwealth has one of the
14	most robust Native American Indian histories; and
15	WHEREAS, Many of the foods we eat and the medicines and
16	remedies we use were introduced by indigenous peoples; and
17	WHEREAS, More than one highway in this Commonwealth follows

1 an original Native American Indian trail; and

2 WHEREAS, The culture and society of indigenous peoples have 3 contributed to agricultural development, medicinal discoveries, 4 environmental preservation, commerce, governmental institutions 5 and structure, music, language, art and many other facets of our 6 country, Commonwealth and cities; and

7 WHEREAS, Most Native American Indian tribes were forced to 8 leave Pennsylvania during the 1700s when indigenous peoples were 9 being displaced by colonial expansion; and

10 WHEREAS, Those indigenous peoples not displaced by 11 colonialism were forced to assimilate into European society; and 12 WHEREAS, From the 1800s through the 1900s, the race of many 13 southern and northern Native American Indians was mislabeled, 14 resulting in the dilution of their identities; and

15 WHEREAS, There are no federally recognized Native American 16 Indian tribes or reservations in this Commonwealth today; and 17 WHEREAS, Many indigenous peoples living in our counties, 18 cities, townships, boroughs and towns have persevered through 19 great adversity, trauma and tragedy to maintain their cultural 20 and ethnic identities; and

21 WHEREAS, According to 2018 United States Census Bureau 22 estimates, out of a population of approximately 12.8 million, 23 more than 64,000 Pennsylvanians identify solely as Native 24 American Indian and Alaska Native or solely as Native Hawaiian 25 and other Pacific Islander; and

26 WHEREAS, Indigenous peoples and their cultures are to be 27 respected and honored across this Commonwealth and the nation; 28 and

29 WHEREAS, The importance of educating the residents of this 30 Commonwealth about the heritage, history, art, archeology and

1 traditions of indigenous peoples and communities in this

2 Commonwealth is acknowledged; and

3 WHEREAS, By celebrating and honoring indigenous peoples, we 4 reaffirm our commitment to appreciating their unique cultural 5 heritage and ethnic identities; and

6 WHEREAS, Properly recognizing indigenous peoples and their 7 contributions to and influences on this Commonwealth and the 8 nation throughout history is necessary to rectify historical 9 inaccuracies; therefore be it

10 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the 11 week following the second Monday in October as "Indigenous 12 Peoples Week" in Pennsylvania; and be it further 13 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the 14 month of October 2019 as "Indigenous Peoples Month" in 15 Pennsylvania; and be it further

16 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives encourage all 17 Pennsylvanians to acknowledge and celebrate the cultures and 18 values of indigenous peoples and to continue efforts to promote 19 the well-being and growth of Pennsylvania's indigenous 20 community.
