| 15     | time wins list, 7th in strikeouts and 16th in shutouts; and   |
| 16     | WHEREAS, Mr. Blass was on the mound October 17, 1971, when  |

the Pittsburgh Pirates ended the season with a championship win
during World Series Game 7, Pittsburgh Pirates at Baltimore
Orioles; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Blass is the last National League pitcher to 4 have thrown a complete game in Game 7 of a World Series; and 5 WHEREAS, Mr. Blass displayed more of his natural talents, for 6 7 recall and storytelling, and met another significant career goal 8 in his work with the Pittsburgh Pirates' broadcast team; and 9 WHEREAS, Stepping away from the broadcast booth in September 2019 after 34 seasons, Mr. Blass is set to represent the 10 Pittsburgh Pirates as an ambassador in the 2020 season; and 11 12 WHEREAS, The House of Representatives extends best wishes as 13 Mr. Blass embarks on new paths with his family and his cherished 14 Pittsburgh Pirates fans; therefore be it
