2 WHEREAS, In 2018, 17,948 registered apprentices practiced their trade in Pennsylvania, ranking this Commonwealth among the 3 top 10 in the United States in number of active apprentices; and 4 5 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania had 798 active programs in 2018; and 6 WHEREAS, More than 1,870 Pennsylvania apprentices completed their training in 2018; and 7 8 WHEREAS, In 2018, the number of registered new apprentices and apprenticeship programs in Pennsylvania continued to grow to 9 10 5,013 and 42, respectively; and WHEREAS, Pennsylvania continues to be at the forefront of 11 12 apprenticeship training; therefore be it 13 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the 14 week of November 11 through 17, 2019, as "National Apprenticeship Week" in Pennsylvania. 15
