A RESOLUTION

- Directing the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee to study the reasons for the decline in hunting licenses.
- 3 WHEREAS, Numbers of hunting licenses being issued by the
- 4 Pennsylvania Game Commission are declining as shown by the drop
- 5 in hunting licenses being issued from 943,945 in 2014 to 855,486
- 6 in 2018, with an anticipated reduction of 7,357 licenses issued
- 7 in the current fiscal year; and
- 8 WHEREAS, This decline appears to be the result of numerous
- 9 factors which could include lack of educational opportunities
- 10 for young people to learn about hunting and gun safety and lack
- 11 of understanding regarding the importance of game management in
- 12 this Commonwealth; and
- 13 WHEREAS, In addressing issues of hunting and game management,
- 14 the General Assembly does not have ready resources to help it
- 15 develop comprehensive legislation to reverse the decline in
- 16 hunting licenses; therefore be it
- 17 RESOLVED, That the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee

- 1 be directed to undertake a study that:
- 2 (1) surveys the literature to determine what national
- and Pennsylvania studies have been undertaken relative to
- 4 public attitudes toward hunting;
- 5 (2) identifies any commonalities in attitudes toward
- 6 hunting that prompt decisions to not obtain a hunting
- 7 license; and
- 8 (3) analyzes current Pennsylvania Game Commission game
- 9 management practices that might impact game populations
- 10 relative to hunting;
- 11 and be it further
- 12 RESOLVED, That the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee
- 13 prepare a report within one year of the adoption of this
- 14 resolution and submit it to the Game and Fisheries Committee of
- 15 the Senate and the Game and Fisheries Committee of the House of
- 16 Representatives.
