A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 Signifying the intent of the General Assembly to pass
2 legislation requiring a nonbinding referendum to gauge the
3 degree of support for a tax increase to fund public education
4 programs and services.

5 RESOLVED (the Senate concurring), That the General Assembly
6 signify its intent to pass legislation requiring that a
7 nonbinding referendum question be placed on the May 2014 primary
8 ballot; and be it further

9 RESOLVED, That the nonbinding referendum gauge the degree of
10 support of the residents of this Commonwealth for State elected
11 officials, in conjunction with the Governor, to raise the sales
12 and use tax, personal income tax or corporate net income or
13 other business tax, or a combination of any of these taxes, for
14 the sole purpose of providing a dedicated funding source for
15 public education programs and services.
